

Foundation Award Coaching Course

The Kilmacud Crokes Coaching & Games Committee are organising a Foundation Award Coaching Course which will have the Theory part covered online and the Practical parts delivered in the club.

The course is designed for Parents/Helpers/Teachers or new Coaches who want to get involved in the Club and in Coaching. Coaches must have a Foundation Award Certificate if they wish to progress up the Coaching ladder.

Course Details: Participants will have to complete 7 online coaching modules of the course. Each module will take 30 minutes to complete. Participants will then have to complete practical sessions on Fundamental Movement Skills, Hurling or Football skills (attendance at both Hurling & Football practical sessions are necessary to receive a certificate in both codes). Please note - Participants must complete all 7 online modules before commencing the Practical Sessions. See below details for the Practical Sessions:
